## BOARD OF TRUSTEES POLICY STATEMENT

Section 2 Academic and Student Services

Policy 2.490 Presidential Scholarships

As part of its commitment to recognize academic achievement, the Board of Trustees desires to strengthen an existing scholarship program which will supplement the College's Academic Excellence Scholarship. This program is the President's Academic Scholarship, and applications are to be accepted from Beaver County residents who graduate from any high school in Beaver County.

The scholarship is to be a full two-year tuition scholarship with initial and continuing eligibility requirements. One scholarship will be awarded annually, based on class rank, to a high school graduate from each high school in Beaver County. Students applying for the scholarship must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and have not met the eligibility requirements for the Academic Excellence Scholarship. The Board directs the President to develop procedures for implementation of the scholarship program. The procedures are to require that students apply for financial aid, to delineate the procedures for application and selection and to establish requirements for continuing eligibility.

The procedures established in conjunction with this policy shall be considered in effect for scholarship applicants for the 2006-2007 academic year.
