Institutional Procedure for Presidential Scholarships

Policy Reference: 2.490 Presidential Scholarships

The Presidential Scholarship is available to Beaver County residents who are enrolled as seniors in any high school in Beaver County. The scholarship is to be a full two-year tuition scholarship with initial and continuing eligibility requirements. One scholarship will be awarded annually to the top ranked student that is not eligible for the Academic Excellence Scholarship from each high school in Beaver County. Students applying for the scholarship must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0.

The scholarship is not contingent upon financial aid. It covers tuition and fees, excluding flight fees and academic enhancement fees, for the fall and spring semesters. It is automatically renewed for the sophomore year provided the scholar maintains full-time status with a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative grade point average by the end of the second semester. Applicants must apply for College admission and complete and return the Presidential Scholarship application by May 1 of the year in which they plan to graduate. All applicants must complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Financial Aid) to determine PHEAA State grant and Pell Grant eligibility.

The scholarship is not assignable, transferable, or refundable in cash or tuition value.
